District Reformation Services: The Minnesota District has organized two festival services celebrating God's grace in the Lutheran Reformation. The first service will be held on October 29th at the Chapel of the Christ on the campus of Martin Luther College in New Ulm. That service begins at 3:00 p.m. The president of our district, Rev.
