Congregational Potluck Meal: There will be a potluck meal on Sunday, January 18th before the annual meeting. Everyone is invited.

Voters' Meeting: The annual voters' meeting will be held on January 18th, starting at 12:15 p.m. At this meeting, the voters will hear the final reports of 2025 from the financial secretary (our offerings) the treasurer (our expenses) and committees, they will set a budget for 2025, they will elect men to serve on the church council, and they will approve our annual mission subscription to WELS. The voters will also act on a proposal to disburse the funds we will receive from the Bailey Family Estate in 2026 to: 1) WELS Home Missions; 2) WELS World Missions; 3) Martin Luther College; and, 4) Immanuel.

Mission Festival: Our mission festival is scheduled for January 25, 2026. Rev. Jacob Behnken, Dean of Chapel and Professor of Music at Martin Luther College, will be at Immanuel on that day to lead worship and make a presentation on MLC. There will also be a meal served after Pastor Behnken's presentation. There is no cost for the meal but please sign up on the sheet in the Narthex so that we know how much food to purchase.

Mission Festival Offerings: There are two options if you would like to support our project for Mission Festival. There is a special envelope included in your offering envelope packet. There will also be a free-will offering after the Service on January 25th.

Clinic administrators IN Malawi and Zambia have earned their Masters Degrees-in hospital administration and public health respectively with support from CAMM.
